



A Quick How to Guide: Mango Languages

Mango is a language learning app with courses in over 70 languages including ESL courses from 20+ non-English languages. Interactive courses cover pronunciation, grammar, and vocabulary.

What you need

1. A valid WPL library card
2. The Mango app downloaded on your device of choice, or internet access on your personal computer.

Open Mango one of two ways:

- **Phone or Tablet:** Download Mango Languages for iOS or Android through your device's app store.
- **Computer:** visit: www.mangolanguages.com.

Logging into the Mango App

- **Mobile App:**
 1. After opening the app for the first time, you will be prompted to sign up.
 - Tap "Start Learning."
 - Tap the language you want to learn.
 - Tap "Skip To Signup."
 - Enter your email address.
 - Create a password.
 2. Read and accept the Terms and Conditions by tapping the box underneath "Create Password."
 3. On the Unlock More Lessons page, tap "Search" beside Find Free Mango.
 4. Type 'Woodstock' in the search bar to find the Woodstock Public Library.
 5. Tap "Woodstock Public Library."
 6. Enter your library card number then tap "Access Mango."
 7. Tap "Continue."
- **Computer Web Browser:**
 1. After opening the www.mangolanguages.com website, click "Sign Up" in the top right-hand corner of your screen.
 - Type in your email address.
 - Create a password.
 2. Read and accept the Terms and conditions by clicking "I Agree."

3. Click on the language you would like to learn.
4. Click "Search" under Find Free Mango to access Mango through the Woodstock Public Library.
5. Type Woodstock into the search bar.
6. Click "Woodstock Public Library."
7. Type in your library card number.

Navigating the Site:

- **Mobile App:**

Along the bottom of the screen, you will see a tool bar with four buttons.

 1. Learn: will display the tutorials for the chapter you are working on, and your current progress highlighted in green.
 2. Vocabulary: has vocab cards to aid in memorization.
 3. Review: is a once-a-day daily review to help commit words and phrases to long term memory.
 4. Resume Learning is the round purple button that continues the lesson where you left off.
- **Computer Web Browser:**

Along the top of the screen, you will see a toolbar with four large buttons.

 1. Learn: will display the tutorials for the chapter you are working on, and your current progress highlighted in green.
 2. Vocabulary: has vocab cards to aid in memorization.
 3. Tools: translates the basis of a conversation between two different languages.
